- Preparing for Graduation needs, we host concessions plus sell bouquets, candy cups and fans; we also presell these items.
- Trying to end season without excess product to be fresh for Fall.
- Question from LaShira- no more Mr Pita or hotdogs?
 - Depending on event is how it is determined what we purchase to sell. Always looking for ways to minimize cost and time it takes for product handling. Still having issued finding normal concession items/supplies.
- We have 4 large events to get thru for year.
- Question on credit allocation for an incoming freshman? you chose when you work an event where your earned credit would be paid to.
- What are the fans? Handheld fans that we ordered last year to sell on graduation day only. They are generic for graduation- no year. It can get quite warm up in the stands during ceremony.

- What is in the candy cups? We make them up as chocolate based or sugar candy based. We use a variety of the candy we sell. We try and presell as much as we can, it helps with the planning.
- We will have blankets to sell in fall.
 - Based on a student committee- they are tired of the "D" they feel it is dated. We took this into advisement when picking our blanket design.
- We are looking into options of a generic sweatshirt to sell also.

Craft Show Trustee Report- Shari Burnham

- Craft show was held 3/18.
- Huge success.
- Attendance just under 2000 shoppers.
- 172 crafters selling their wares.
- Crafters very happy with our student help. Students help with set up and tear down, we have lots of volunteers to help the day go smoothly.
- Holiday craft show is November 4.
- We have sold 50% of vendor spots that are available.
- Spring 2024 Craft show will be March 9 or 16, will be checking with AD on potential conflict with basketball season before date is confirmed.
