- Call to Order & Welcome- Shari Burnham, President
  - Meeting called to order at 7:43pm
- Committee Reports/ Old Business
  - o **President Report-** Shari Burnham nothing to report.
  - Secretary's Reports/Approvals- Joyce Cronin
    - March General Meeting Minutes were presented for review. Motion to approve made by Karri Rogers, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rachel Lasater. Motion carried.
  - Treasurer's Report/Approvals- Shari Burnham

    - On April 6<sup>th</sup>, Band competed at Western MI University. The Combined Winter Guard took 1<sup>st</sup> place at states- Michigan Color Guard Circuit for Scholastic Regional A.

- All Board positions are being promoted in social media. Stephanie has asked Mr. Koskos to promote us on his Instagram account also.
- Stephanie stated she will be making posts more frequently.
- Shari stated that the Board has declared that all are returning in some position except her.

#### Concession Report- Joyce Cronin/Rachel Lasater

- For some events, spectators do not know that concessions are open. It was asked if we could ask Shane if the front gate could be unlocked for all events. Shari stated we should request from him events that the tunnel is used as primary entrance, could we unlock the side gate. We would then be responsible for locking that gate. It was suggested to post a sign near the tunnel that concessions are open or to make sure it is announced. It was suggested to inquire if it could be announced on the scoreboard about concessions.
- Stephanie stated that we are having issues with the main door of the side storage unit. We have difficulties opening it when the sun has been out. This caused a delay in cooking hot dogs at the last track event. It was suggested that we keep a couple of extra propane tanks on visitor's side. Then we only have to retrieve them. It was pointed out that last year, we had to move the propane out of the equipment room where electrical panel is. Keeping the propane in that room is a hazard.
- The ice machine on home side needs a new liner. Joyce will ask that the ice machine on visitor's side be turned on.

- Stephanie pointed out that we need to repaint or put up something on the wall behind the popcorn machines. It was discovered during clean up that the paint has started to flake off that wall. Joyce will reach out about this also. This may be a request to the district though.
