- Committee Reports/ Old Business
 - **President Report-** nothing to report.
 - Secretary's Reports/Approvals- Joyce Cronin
 - November's general meeting minutes were presented. Motion to approve made by Kimberly Heugh, 2nd by Dawn Schlitt. Motion carried.
 - There was no meeting in January due to weather. In December it would have only been an Executive meeting.
 - Treasurer's Report/Approvals- Dawn Schlitt
 - Treasurer's Report for November, December and January presented.

 - Vice President Report- Michelle Steinhebel, nothing to report.
 - Sports Trustee Report- Karri Rogers
 - All winter coaches were contacted via email with contact information for Karri, as well as information regarding donation request procedures.
 - Compiling a list of spring sports activities/coaches to email them.
 - Dance team traveled to Orlando and competed in the Union National Championships: JV placed 2nd in Pom and 3rd in Jazz. Varsity placed 3rd in Jazz and 1st in Pom, earning back-to-back National Championships in the Medium Pom Division.

- DHS wrestling team won Team Regionals, defeating Chippewa Valley and Romeo to qualify for Team States next weekend in Kalamazoo.
- Boys baseball/Girls softball season will begin both their seasons with an informational meeting for all interested players: Baseball meeting is March 6th in the community room and Softball meeting is February 29th in the community room. Both will be held after school.
- Donation requests received from Softball and Dance.
- Cultural and Fine Arts Trustee Report-Michelle Steinhebel
 - Mamma Mia! Sold out 2 performances. First time since before Covid has this happened.
 - In January, solo & ensemble choir, 4 students achieved a perfect score (Alaina Carlson, Dante Dagati, Sal Vitale and Nadia Bronzino) All 4 will compete for All States at state solo & ensemble April 12th & 13th.
 - Choir Festival is March 4th.
 - A Wrinkle in Time will be performed April 18th-20th.
 - Spring Spectacular is May 17th, senior song voting ends Friday the 16th.
 - Band and Choir students from Dakota & Chippewa Valley band students will be in NYC in March.
 - Fine Art All Night Party is scheduled for May 31st.
 - In January solo 7 ensemble, 32 band students received a #1 rating, 10 students received a #2 rating. Many will be competing at All States on March 16th.
 - Drumline & combined Winter Guard show will be February 26ht for friends and family.
 - Competitive season is starting in March, check DakotaBands.com website for dates and locations.
 - Guard is currently in 1st place by 10 points.
 - Marching band meeting is February 27th.
 - 12th annual cheesecake fundraiser going on now, link is on PaySchool Events. Delivery is before Spring break.
 - Vertical Raise starting end of month for upcoming marching season.
 - Band Festival is hosting Middle School March 1st & 2nd and high school March 7ht & 8ht, up to 10 different schools competing each day.
 - Band Spring Concert is May 19th, 4 staff members will be getting pies in their faces due to Win the Band ticket sales.
- Service & Scholastic Leadership Trustee Report-Vacant-nothing to report.
- Volunteer/Donation Trustee- Joyce Cronin
 - Drumline requested \$1,157.95 for drumheads. This was approved electronically January 29.
 - JV Football requested \$401.06 for undefeated championship t-shirts, request was approved.

- Softball requested \$100 for a cornhole sponsorship + a blanket to raffle at their fundraiser. Donation was approved.
- Dance inquired about championship t-shirts. They were advised that they will need to complete donation request form and submit it.
- Winter payout # 1 for earned credits up to 01/13 was paid out for a total of 69 credits valued at \$2,760.

 - Thank you goes out to all volunteers who continue to support Boosters by volunteering.
- Craft Show Trustee Report- Shari Burnham
 - Show is sold out.
- o Student Trustee- Mario Qualgia
 - Fight Cancer week was successful. Collected \$2100 from bottle drive, and \$1700 in t-shirt sales and online donations. Collected \$350 from ice cream sales. Overall \$4100 donated to fight cancer.
- School Administrative Report-Attending Administrators- Mr. Koskos
 - 2nd semester has started, things are going well. Curriculum night was this past Monday, it was well attended.
 - Mamma Mia! Was a great show. Also attended the wind ensemble at the Devos Center in Grand Rapids.
 - Dakota fights cancer week went well with their fundraising.
 - Euchre tournament this week. It went fast with 16 teams playing in 1 ½ hours.
 - 4 teachers were awarded a mini grant from CV Foundation.
 - Parent teacher conferences will be after winter break. There will be one virtual day and 1 in person.
 - Community scholarship applications are due 03/01.
 - NHS blood drive is 3/15.
 - Spring craft show is 3/16.
 - There is a proposal to have an advising period, 80% of the teachers need to support it for it to pass. The advising period would be 1x per week, flexible as to what the time is used for, it could be a catch-up time as well. The program would be different for each student/teacher, it would be based on needs. It's projected to be in the middle of the day, possibly lunch period on Wednesdays. The ratio would be 1/22: teacher to student, but the teacher assigned to a group might not be a regular teacher of the student. The idea is to have a different adult that the student can go to that isn't an influencer to their grades/classes.
