  - Sports Trustee Report-Karri Rogers
    - Fall student athletes attended the "Life of an Athlete" presentation on
      9/18 hosted by John Underwood. Students were given information on

- Rivalry week: Dakota Football Teams are preparing for rivalry week

- Cultural and Fine Arts Trustee Report-Michelle Steinhebel
  - Choir-Tryouts for MamaMia! have been completed. First rehearsal is September 18.
    - Homecoming Parade is September 22.
    - Holiday Concert is December 15.
  - Collage concert is October 19 & 20.
  - Band-Michelle asked Shane Finney if band has access to HUDL? Shane stated "Yes, they do."

#### Volunteer/Donation Trustee- Joyce Cronin

- We approved the donation request from Football for \$10,129. This is to purchase 9 headphones and 2 charging stations for the coaches to use during practice and games.
- We approved Lacrosse request for \$2433.38 to purchase uniform shorts with the new logo in 3 colors.
- Volunteers can sign up in the Signup Genius for events. You can access it thru the weekly announcements or in our Weebly.
  - We are asking for each season, you only sign up for 2 shifts to allow more people the opportunity to volunteer. But if there is an opening 72 hours before a scheduled event, you can sign up even if you have already singed up/worked 2 events in that season.
     Craft show is considered its own season.
  - Volunteer credit is \$40 this school year.
- It was asked if Craft show is still in need of volunteers? Girls Tennis lost their coach, but team is looking to fundraise. Shari asked if they could discuss this after meeting.
  - For student volunteering as a group for craft show, a parent or coach will need to be present to oversee that group. Shari would need to know how many students would be volunteering also.

### Concession Report- vacant

- New crowd control, stanchions were purchased to help create a better line. It is a work in progress. We are looking for ways to shorten lines.
- With homecoming around corner, Phill Vernengo will oversee Cougar Fest.
  - Phil provided this information: the event will be inside the stadium, under the bleachers and at the other end of stadium. There will be food trucks and games. Phil is still working on food trucks but has confirmed Kona Ice and Dario's ice cream truck. There will be vendors with tables under the bleachers. It was just approved to hold event inside stadium. People will need to

- purchase a ticket to enter even if they were not staying to watch game.
- Community Choice CU would like to pay for food items purchased at concessions, they are donating \$750 for this endeavor. They are requesting that as people are receiving free items, they are informed it was paid for by community Choice CU.
- We have blankets back in stock, same weight, and quality but new design.
  Blankets are \$75. They can be purchased thru our online store or at concessions.

## Craft Show Trustee Report- Shari Burnham

- Fall Craft show is Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup>.
- The show is sold out with 203 crafters selling out of 233 booths. It was sold out in July; Shari has removed the online registrations. There is a waitlist of 50 crafters, if any vendor cancels, she is filling from the waitlist. She has a crafter who has been in show for last 26 years miss out since they registered a bit later than others.
- Shari will create the Signup Genius; it will be posted soon.
- Last year there were 4700 shoppers, she is anticipating an increase in attendance.
- Spring craft show will be March 16.
